Handlers must wear white coats and be at least 7 years of age on the day of the show. To be halter led and handler will be asked rudimentary questions on their animal. Rosettes will be awarded and prize cards. **There is NO entry fee.**  
THE FRANK SMITH PERPETUAL CHALLENGE CUP will be awarded to the champion.
