Radnor YFC General Rules

- 1) All competitors must be currently paid-up members. **Competitors will be required to show their membership card either on their phone or a printed copy.**
- 2) White coats must be worn were specified. Competitors not wearing white coats when they should be will have 10 marks deducted from their final mark.
- 3) For the purpose of Kington Show, the following age limits will apply:
28 years of age and under, 21 years of age and under, 18 years of age and under, 16 years of age on the 1st September 2024.
- 4) Competitors must arrive on time and report to the competition steward before the start of the competition to book in with the necessary equipment to complete the competition. See rule 6 regarding the procedure if a competitor is going to be late for their competition. Any competitor arriving late without prior notification may be penalised, at the discretion of the judge.
- 5) Competitors will be disqualified if they contact the public by speech or sign while a competition is in progress or talk with each other in the stock judging rings. Stewards will be required to warn competitors and then to report the incident to the elected Complaints Panel for decision.
- 6) **Each Club to appoint their own Chief Steward** ~ a non-competing person who will be responsible for informing competition Stewards and Announcers if a competitor is late reporting for a competition or will not be reporting at all. Name of Chief Steward to be included on entry form.
- 7) Special requirements - If any member has any special requirements when competing in a competition, then please do not hesitate to contact the County Office, if possible, a week before the competition is due to take place.
- 8) **In all competitions, the Judge's decision is final, and no harassment is to be given to the Judges by any YFC Member or General Public.**
- 9) All trestle tables will be 6 or 8 feet.
- 10) All exhibits must be left on view to the public until 5.00 pm when they can then be removed. If removed before 5pm, clubs will be placed **20 points** below the lowest placed club in that competition.
- 11) Radnor YFC will not be held responsible for any items left on display after 6.00 pm.
- 12) Members turning up late for the first competitions of the day, will be given no extra time to complete the competition. There will be zero tolerance on this rule. No excuses.
- 13) No electric will be available for competitors on the day.

RULES: RE: TOTAL DISQUALIFICATION

A) If a competitor is found to be over the stated age, this will lead to total disqualification.

B) The County Chair, Vice Chair, Competitions Chair and Competitions Vice-Chair have the right to disqualify any competitor should they feel that the person is under the influence of alcohol.

C) Infringement of Rules

Any infringement of the rules will result in a competitor being placed at the bottom with a difference of ten points to the next highest placed competitor.

D) Complaints to be received in writing and accompanied by £20 and handed to the Chief Officer within one hour of the alleged grievance. A panel will give ruling. If the complaint is upheld the £20 will be refunded.

PANEL: County Chair; County Vice-Chair; Competitions Chair; Competitions Vice-Chair, plus Steward/s of the Competition in question.



STOCKJUDGING CLASSES

CLASS 1 STOCKJUDGING – FAT LAMBS

9.30AM

One team of two members - one 28 years and under, one 18 years and under on 1st September 2024.

Each competitor will be required to judge one ring of **FAT LAMBS** and place in order of merit.

The animals will be designated A, B, X, Y and competitors will be allowed 10 minutes to view, handle, and place in the ring and two minutes to state their reasons to the judge. 2 marks per 15 seconds (or part thereof) will be deducted from the total score if this time limit is exceeded.

CLASS 2 STOCKJUDGING – BREEDING EWES

9.30AM

One team of two members - one 28 years and under, one 18 years and under on the 1st September 2024.

Each competitor will be required to judge one ring of **FOUR BREEDING EWES** and place in order of merit.

The animals will be designated A, B, X, Y and competitors will be allowed 10 minutes to view, handle and place in the ring and two minutes to state their reasons to the judge. 2 marks per 15 seconds (or part thereof) will be deducted from the total score if this time limit is exceeded.

CLASS 3 - FLOWER ARRANGEMENT - JUNIOR

'Harvest Home'

10.00AM

One member, 16 years and under on the 1st September 2024. Competitors will be required to make a **FRONT FACING, ARRANGEMENT DEPICTING "HARVEST HOME"**.

The maximum cost of the flowers; £20. Receipts to be displayed.

Backboards are allowed to be used.

Exhibit 60cm wide x 60cm deep x unlimited height.

An exhibit composed of natural plant material with or without accessories, contained within a space as specified above.

All arrangements must be assembled during the competition. Competitors to bring their own materials, equipment etc.

Allowance of one hour, with a further ten minutes to check that arrangements have not been disturbed during clearing-up operations.

Competitors required to wear a white coat.

CLASS 4 - FLOWER ARRANGEMENT - SENIOR

'Autumn Wreath'

10.00AM

One member, 28 years and under on the 1st September 2024.

PROCEDURE

To prepare a circular Autumn wreath suitable for hanging on a door using foliage, seed heads etc to reflect what is found in the British countryside.

Competitors to bring their own 10" plain wreath, made from wire and moss, and competitors must supply all other materials. Wreaths must be displayed hung – competitors to provide a hanging facility that will be erected on the table provided.

Competitors required to wear a white coat.

TIMING

One hour is allowed to decorate the Autumn wreath.

CLASS 5 – GROUP KAROKE SINGING

2.00PM

ONE team of between TWO and FIVE competitors per Club all of whom must be 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2024.

PROCEDURE

The group will select a track at random from a selection of karaoke songs, they will be given 10 minutes to practice their performance and familiarise themselves with the song and words. A selection of items will be available for members to use to during their performance if they wish.

CLASS 6 – SCAVENGER HUNT

11:30PM

Open to two teams of two competitors per club aged 28 years and under on 1st September 2024. Competitors will be required to scavenge the show site for a list of items as supplied by the Judge on the day. Maximum time allowed = 30 minutes.

Marks will be awarded as follows:

Scale of Marking: First placed team **100**

Second placed team **90**

Third placed team **80**

Fourth placed team **70**

Fifth placed team **60**

Sixth placed team and below **50** Competitors failing to find all the items on the list will have marks deducted at a rate of **3** points per item, to a maximum loss of **30** points.

Competitors required to wear a white coat.

CLASS 7 - COOKERY – STAGED- SIX WELSH CAKES

9.30AM

Open to two members per club aged 28 years and under on 1st September 2024. Competitors will be required to make 6 WELSH CAKES. Competitors are required to display a recipe card showing ingredients and method. MAXIMUM space allowed 50cm x 50cm x unlimited height (this is to include the recipe card). All food items MUST be covered with Cling Film. Competitors MUST provide 4 photos showing the stages of production of their bake.

CLASS89 - METAL WORK - STAGED

9.30AM

One member, 28 years of age and under on 1st September 2024. Competitors are to produce a "**METAL WORK ITEM USING FARM RECYLED MATERIALS**". Space allowed 80cm x 80cm x unlimited height. ITEMS ARE TO BE SUITABLY DISPLAYED.

Photos must be provided showing the competitor's work through the stages of production.

CLASS 9 – ‘It’s a Knockout’ NO LATE COMPETITORS-HAS TO START ON TIME

1.00PM

Four members, two members 28 years of age and under and two members 16 and under on 1st September 2024. **TASK** All members of the team to compete in an ‘It’s a Knockout’ style race, with all members dressed up using the theme ‘Farm Animals’.

Each team will then compete in an It’s a Knockout style race where the fastest team will gain the highest number of points.

CLASS 10 – Agricultural Sit and draw

The cake may be covered in FONDANT ICING prior to the competition but no other decoration is to be added. MAXIMUM space allowed 45cm wide X 45cm deep X unlimited height.

Competitors required to wear a white coat.

Maximum time **1 hour**

CLASS 12 - SCRAPBOOK - STAGED

Each club to bring their 2023/2024 scrapbook for display purposes only for which **100** points will be awarded. SCRAPBOOKS NEED TO BE IN THE YFC MARQUEE & STAGED BY 9.30am.

CLASS 13 – 5 A DAY CHALLENGE

11.30AM

One member, 16 years of age and under of the 1st September 2024. Competitors to construct "**AN ANIMAL**" using only fruit and vegetables. Competitors are to provide their own fruit and vegetables.

Competitors required to wear a white coat.

CLASS 14 – DECORATE A WELLY – STAGED

One member, 21 years of age and under on the 1st September 2024. Competitors to decorate a welly.

CLASS 15 – CHEERLEADING

ONE team of between FOUR and EIGHT competitors per Club all of whom must be 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2024.

Each team is required to perform a cheerleading routine to promote British Farming.

Safety Clarification: for the purpose of this competition tumbling is a gymnastic element and a stunt is a lift. Tumbling- allowed forward and backward rolls, cartwheels, front and back walk overs. **NOT** allowed tumbling that involves a sprig or run i.e. flips somersaults, handsprings. **No** stunts to be more than one and a half persons high. **Please consider health and safety as you will be performing on a lorry container.**

Competitors required to wear a white coat.

CLASS 17 – ‘LUNCHBOX FOR A FARMER HARVESTING’

10:30AM

Open to one member per club aged 28 years and under on 1st September 2023. Competitors are required to make a ‘LUNCHBOX FOR A FARMER HARVESTING’. Competitors are required to provide their own equipment, ingredients, and must include nutritional values. No items are to be prepared beforehand. The LUNCHBOX MUST be covered with cling film by the competitor. Competitors are required to wear a white coat. **NO HEAT IS TO BE USED FOR THIS COMPETITION.**

Display area = 68cm wide x 68cm deep x unlimited height. Maximum time allowed = 45 minutes.
